We are salmon farmers. We are passionate about our role in the food system and are committed to the health of the waters we raise our stock in and bringing long-term economic health benefits to the communities we operate from.

We know there are questions about the Tasmanian salmon farming industry. This is where our commitment to transparency can help bust myths and opinions about Tasmanian farmed salmon.

In Tassie, we find that everyone knows a salmon farmer or someone who works in the broader industry, in fact, we estimate one in 20 Tasmanians are directly or indirectly employed by the salmon industry.

For us, we've been farming here for 35 years, and today, we have over 1100 people come to work every day from across regional Tasmanian communities.

Our farms, hatcheries and processing plants are spread across regional Tasmania. We estimate nearly an additional 10,000 Tasmanian families, and their communities are supported by our industry.

The industry also spends ~\$500 million on local suppliers annually, from purchasing equipment and product from manufacturers to transport providers.

Through continued improvement across our operations and maintaining Aquaculture certifications, Tassal is committed to providing an alternative delicious protein that is produced responsibly straight from the beautiful, cool waters of Tasmania.
